BOOK AWARDS

Last term CVEA students were involved in casting their votes for the North East Book Award and the Teen North East Book Award.

North East Book Award

There were 6 books on the shortlist from YA verse novels to thrillers, fantasy novels to dystopian stories. The book that came out top for students at CVEA and the overall winner was **Happyhead** - best described as Squid Game meets They Both Die at the End in the first in a thrilling new YA series.



North East Teen Book Award

There were 4 books on the shortlist. The book that came out top for students at CVEA and the overall winner was **The Wall Between Us** - an emotional, atmospheric story from Carnegie Medal-nominated north east author Dan Smith

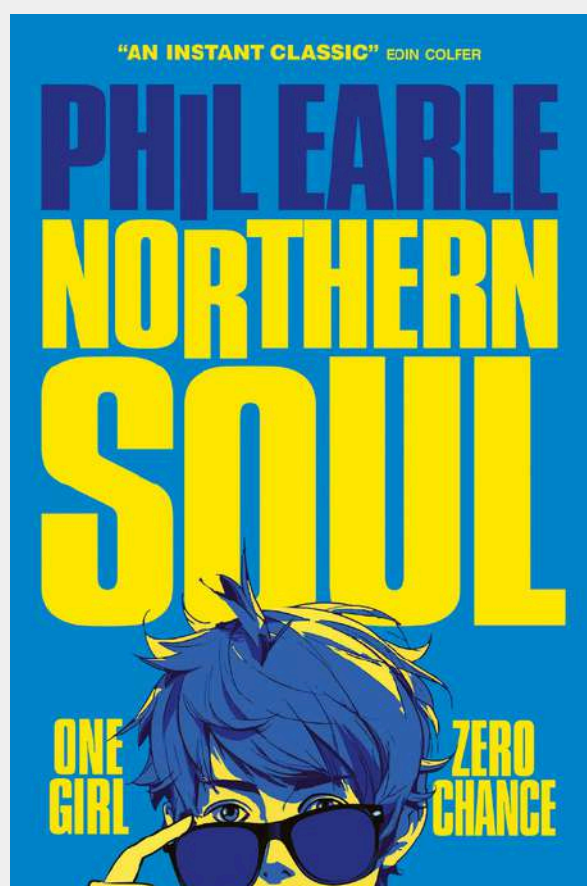
WE ARE CONSTANTLY ADDING NEW BOOKS TO OUR COLLECTION

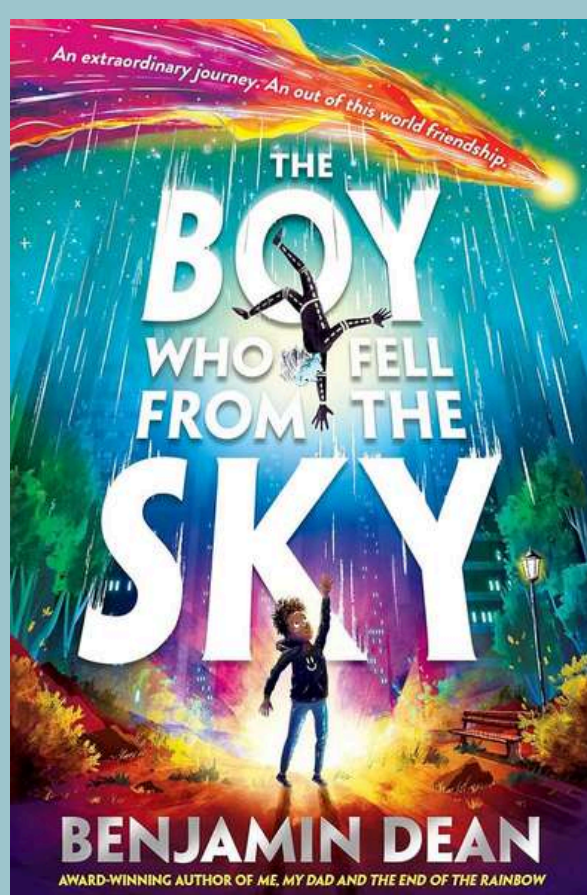

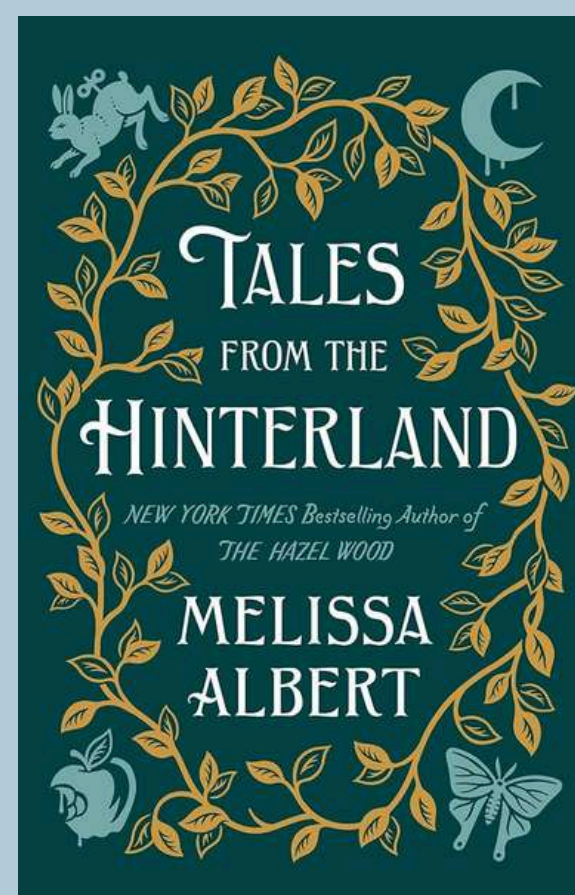

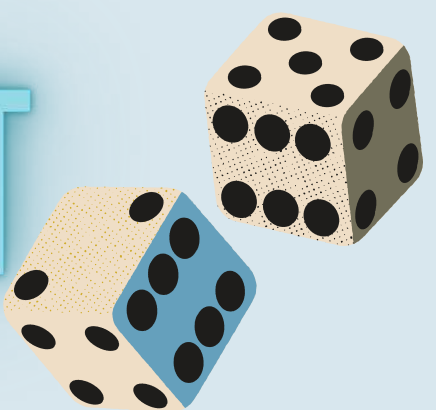
